1. Provide a copy of valid State Hunting License and Photo Identification.
2. OWNER of property must provide signed written consent to allow applicant to hunt on the property and has right to include any restrictions imposed by the landowner.
3. Hunters MUST comply with all State Fish and Game regulations, Township of Morris Ordinances and all other applicable State statutes.

Applicants; by signing below you shall indemnify and hold Morris Township and its agents harmless from all suits, judgments, cost, fees, claims, actions, attorney's fees and any claims of like nature. Applicants understand the provisions of Township Ordinance Chapter 265 Firearms and Weapons and the State Fish and Game laws that regulates the proposed hunt.

ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE CHECKED FOR PRIOR FISH AND WILDLIFE VIOLATIONS OR OTHER HUNTING RELATED OFFENSES. A PRIOR VIOLATION DOES NOT AUTOMATICALLY RESULT IN THE DENIAL OF A PERMIT, HOWEVER THE CHIEF OF POLICE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DENY ANY APPLICANT WHICH MAY POSE A RISK TO THE SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF MORRIS TOWNSHIP

## INSTRUCTIONS TO OBTAIN A PERMIT TO HUNT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS

Applications can be printed from the Township of Morris website, [www.morristwp.com](http://www.morristwp.com) or by email request to the Morris Township Chief of Police.

1. The applicant MUST comply and review all the provisions of Local Ordinance Chapter 265: Firearms and Weapons. The Township of Morris Ordinance(s) can be accessed and printed at [www.ecode360.com](http://www.ecode360.com).
2. ALL hunters MUST have a VAILD hunting license issued by the State of New Jersey for the current season.
3. All hunters MUST have completed the New Jersey State Hunter Safety class.
4. All hunters MUST complete the Application and answer all questions. Any Application that is incomplete or illegible will be rejected.
5. All Applications MUST have attached a copy of:
  - > State of New Jersey Hunter license.
  - > Photo Identification.
  - > Vehicle Registration if a vehicle permit is requested.
  - > Signed written consent by the property owner that allows hunting.
  - > New Jersey Firearms Identification Card
6. All permits issued will be valid for one (1) year commencing July 1<sup>st</sup> and expiring June 30<sup>th</sup>.
7. Club permits MUST are issued to non-profits corporations only and a copy of its certificate of incorporation must be provided.
8. Each individual hunter MUST complete an Application.
9. Hunters must wear a cap made of daylight fluorescent orange or an outer garment containing at least 200 square inches of fluorescent orange visible from all sides at all times while engaged in hunting.
10. No person may hunt with firearms or any other weapon in the woods or fields or in the waters on Sunday
11. Completed Applications shall be delivered to the Morris Township Police Department 49 Woodland Ave., Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm ONLY.

## **SPECIFICALLY PROHIBITED WHILE HUNTING**

- **Carrying a loaded firearm or nocked arrow within 450 feet of an occupied building or any school playground, except when the owner of the building specifically authorizes a hunter in writing that they may hunt within 450 feet.**

**Persons authorized to hunt within the 450 foot limit must be in the possession of their written permission while hunting.**

- **Discharging a firearm or a bow and arrow on or across highways or roads.**
- **Discharging a firearm or a bow and arrow from a motor vehicle.**
- **Sights which project a spot of light onto the game animal.**
- **Hunting or shooting any wildlife by aid of a light.**
- **Hunting or shooting any wildlife by aid of a light attached to or carried in a vehicle.**
- **Hunting on national wildlife refuges.**
- **Using electronic calling devices.**
- **Carrying loaded firearms in a motor vehicle.**
- **Transporting an uncased firearm in a motor vehicle**

Complete hunting rules and regulations can be found in the current year "Fish and Wildlife Digest" published by the New Jersey State Division of Fish and Wildlife.
