We hope that this will encourage people to start to replace trees that were downed by Sandy, our recent snow storms and Emerald Ash Borer damage. Persimmon – *Diospyros virginiana*

Black Walnut – *Juglans nigra*

Red Cedar – *Juniperus virginiana*

Sweetgum – *Liquidambar styraciflua*

Black Gum – *Nyssa sylvatica*

Norway Spruce – *Picea abies*

Improved Pitch Pine – *Pinus rigida*

White Pine – *Pinus strobus*

Sycamore – *Plantanus occidentalis*

Black Cherry – *Prunus serotina*

White Oak – *Quercus alba*

Pin Oak – *Quercus palustris*

Willow Oak – *Quercus phellos*
