

EMERGENCY EVACUATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

This program tries to identify a family member that may need extra help in getting out of their home during *FIRE* emergencies.

These family members may have; age (infants, young children or elderly, medical conditions, learning disabilities or some other physical handicap(wheel chair, O2 dependent, etc)), working against their immediate evacuation from the home. Rescue of these family members that are incapacitated is of highest priority to the fire department. Valuable seconds can be saved in a rescue if the fire department knows where to look for these family members in the home.

Below you will find the information that the fire department requests. Any and all information obtained by the fire department will remain confidential.
