Route/Direction/MP: **Rte. 202, Mt. Kemble Ave. Northbound & Southbound,
MP 42.19 to 43.23**

Municipality/County: **Morris Township/Morris County**

Nature of work: **Grading, Paving and Retaining Walls**

Anticipated Traffic Impacts: **North Bound Traffic to be detoured around job site and south Bound traffic to run through job site. Also, An alternate North Bound detour will be utilized farther south of the project. Traffic will be detoured down N. maple Ave to Rt.287NB to the Harter Rd Exit. This detour will bypass the planned detour.**

Description of New Traffic Pattern: **From 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM, Rt. 202 NB detour shall be implemented no earlier than 10:00 AM each morning and shall be removed before 8:00 PM the same day. Detours during the weekend shall be approved by the engineer and are subject to the local noise and construction ordinances. Municipal police will be used on an as needed basis. Saturday Hours will be from 9:00AM to 6:00PM. Saturday hours were approved by the Morris Township Engineer according to the Local noise Ordinance.**

**Monday through Friday 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM.
Saturday 9:00AM to 6:00PM**

Proposed Start Date of New Traffic Pattern: **March 3, 2008 to July 1, 2008 for a duration of 120 calendar days from the time the detour is first utilized.**

Any other comments: **VMS boards are in operation and all construction signs have been placed and covered. Signs will be uncovered when detour begins.**
