NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received on or before **Tuesday August 13, 2024 at 11:00am** prevailing time at the Township of Morris Municipal Building, Purchasing Department, 50 Woodland Avenue, Morristown, New Jersey, 07960 at which time and place bids will be opened and read in public for:

Specifications and other proposal information may be obtained at the Administrator's Office/Purchasing Department, Municipal Building, 50 Woodland Avenue, Morristown, New Jersey, 07960 during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.

Bids for the contract must be submitted on standard proposal forms furnished by the Township of Morris in the manner designated therein and required by the Specifications. Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and must be addressed to the Purchasing Department, Township of Morris, 50 Woodland Avenue, PO Box 7603, Convent Station, NJ 07961-7603 and clearly marked "**Ginty and Streeter Swim Pools Ultraviolet Disinfection Equipment**" by **Tuesday August 13, 2024 at 11:00am**. No bids will be accepted after the opening has commenced. Bids may be hand delivered, mailed, or submitted by courier, and must be received by the time, date, and place specified above. The Township of Morris will not assume responsibility for proposals forwarded by mail or delivery service.

The guaranty accompanying the bid proposal shall be given in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid, minimum of \$500.00 and not to exceed twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00), and may be given at the option of the bidder by a Certified Check, Cashier's Check, or a Bid Bond from a reputable insurance company licensed in the State of New Jersey.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17-27. Bids may be held by the Township of Morris for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of bidders, prior to awarding the contract. Pursuant to P.L. 2010, c. 108, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.3 authorizes a bidder to request withdrawal of a public works bid due to a mistake on the part of the bidder within five days after the opening of the bids.

The Township reserves the right to reject all proposals pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2.
