

**TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS
REQUESTS COMPETITIVE CONTRACT PROPOSALS FOR
ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals will be received by the Bid Committee at the Township of Morris, County of Morris, State of New Jersey on Wednesday December 11, 2024 at 2:00 PM prevailing time at the Municipal Building, Public Meeting Room, 50 Woodland Avenue, Morristown, New Jersey, 07960 at which time and place bids will be opened and read in public for:

**COMPETITIVE CONTRACT PROPOSAL
ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES**

Specifications may be obtained at the Administrator's Office/Purchasing Department, Municipal Building, 50 Woodland Avenue, Morristown, New Jersey, 07960 during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.

Proposals for the contract must be submitted on standard proposal forms furnished by the Township of Morris in the manner designated therein and required by the Specifications. Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and must be addressed to the Purchasing Department, Township of Morris, 50 Woodland Avenue, PO Box 7603, Convent Station, NJ 07961-7603 and clearly marked "**Animal Control Services**" by **Wednesday December 11, 2024 at 2:00pm**. No proposals will be accepted after the opening has commenced. Proposals may be hand delivered, mailed, or submitted by courier, and must be received by the time, date, and place specified above. The Township of Morris will not assume responsibility for proposals forwarded by mail or delivery service.

Pursuant to NJSA 52:32-44, all business organizations that conduct business with a New Jersey government agency are required to be registered with the State of New Jersey. Bidders and their subcontractors must submit proof that they are registered with the New Jersey Department of Treasury, Division of Revenue by submitting a copy of their Business Registration Certificate. Failure to provide the Business Registration Certificate prior to award of the contract will be cause for rejection of the bid as being nonresponsive.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17-27. Proposals may be held by the Township of Morris for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of opening of proposals for the purpose of reviewing the proposals and investigating the qualifications of bidders, prior to awarding the contract.

The Township reserves the right to reject all proposals pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2.
