

**TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS
MORRIS COUNTY – NEW JERSEY
ORDINANCE NO. 17-25**

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,560,050 AVAILABLE IN THE SEWER UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$1,560,050 available in the Sewer Utility Capital Improvement Fund of the Township of Morris, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey (the "Township") is hereby appropriated to provide for the following improvements or purposes, including all work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto: (i) \$130,000 for Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) software and hardware improvements for the Butterworth and Woodland Pump Stations; (ii) \$60,000 for lab improvements for the Butterworth and Woodland Pump Stations as set forth on the project list filed in the Department of Engineering; (iii) \$300,000 for various capital improvements for the Butterworth Pump Station as set forth on the project list filed in the Department of Engineering; (iv) \$42,000 for various capital improvements for the Woodland Pump Station as set forth on the project list filed in the Department of Engineering; (v) \$50,000 for various sewer manhole improvements throughout the Township as set forth on the project list filed in the Department of Engineering; (vi) \$50,000 for valve improvements for the Mendham Road Pump Station as set forth on the project list filed in the Department of Engineering; and (vii) \$928,050 for various road improvements throughout the Township as set forth on the project list filed in the Department of Engineering.

Section 2. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect following the first publication thereof after final adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.


