FULL-TIME OPERATOR HELPER/MECHANIC-WPCU

This is a skilled work position in the maintenance & operation of wastewater treatment plants, pump stations, and collection system. Reports to the Maintenance Supervisor, and/or Superintendent/Assistant Superintendent. On-call responsibility for weekday, weekend, and holiday coverage on a rotating basis, and **must live and respond to facilities within 30 minutes.**

Physical Requirements:

- Physically demanding with recurring visits to all areas of the treatment and collection system. There is considerable walking, bending, twisting, lifting 50 lbs. or more, and climbing to get in and out of tanks and pump station wet wells. Also, includes working outdoors in all types of weather.
- Involves safety hazards and confined spaces. Employees will be assigned personal protective equipment and as needed, training. Use of the assigned personal protective equipment(PPE) is an essential function of the job.

Qualifications:

High school graduate or equivalent required. Course work in related area such as seminars, technical school, or college desirable. Related training such as, Right to Know, PPE, Confined Space Entry. Must possess and maintain a valid New Jersey driver's license – Class B CDL. Will be subject to Federal D.O.T. random drug and alcohol testing.

Must have strong mechanical background and strong use of hand and machine tools.
