The Township of Morris is soliciting quotations through a fair and open process for RFQ-3-2019 Department of Public Works Fire Suppression System. Sealed proposals will be received by the Bid Committee of the Township of Morris, County of Morris, State of New Jersey on Wednesday, April 10, 2019 at 11 AM prevailing time at the Municipal Building, Public Meeting Room/Courtroom, 50 Woodland Avenue, Convent Station, New Jersey.

Specifications may be obtained at the Purchasing Department/Administrator's Office, Municipal Building, 50 Woodland Avenue, Convent Station, New Jersey, during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.

Proposals must be submitted on the proposal form furnished by the Township of Morris in the manner designated therein and required by the Specifications. Proposals must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, and must be delivered to the Purchasing Department, Township of Morris, 50 Woodland Ave., PO Box 7603, Convent Station, NJ 07961-7603, and clearly marked on the envelope **RFQ-3-2019 Department of Public Works Fire Suppression System** and shall be delivered on or before **Wednesday, April 10, 2019 at 11:00 AM**. NO PROPOSALS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE BID OPENING HAS COMMENCED. Proposals may be hand delivered, mailed, or submitted by courier, and must be received by the time, date and place specified above. The Township of Morris will not assume responsibility for proposals forwarded by mail or delivery service.

Vendors are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

Pursuant to P.L. 2004, c. 57 (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44) all business organizations that conduct business with a New Jersey government agency are required to be registered with the State of New Jersey. Vendors and their subcontractors must submit proof prior to award of a contract that they are registered with the New Jersey Department of Treasury, Division of Revenue by submitting a copy of their Business Registration Certificate. Failure to provide the Business Registration Certificate prior to award of a contract will be cause for rejection of the proposal as being nonresponsive.

The Township reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, if in its judgment the public interest will be best served by doing so.
