



Continuation of Public Hearing on The Abbey Redevelopment Plan

Dear Residents,

Our Public Hearing on the Abbey will continue this Thursday (9/3/20) starting at 6PM. We concluded our last meeting (which took place on 8/26/20) in the middle of public commentary, so the upcoming meeting will begin with additional public commentary. Every resident who wants to make comment will be given the opportunity to do so.

Information for the Thursday 9/3 Meeting:

- Public Commentary will include both in-person and Zoom participation by residents.
 - Residents who prefer in-person attendance may gather in the parking lot of the Municipal Center.
 - Bringing your own lawn chairs is recommended but not required.
 - Social distancing is required and will be strictly enforced. Masks are strongly encouraged.
 - Weather permitting, we will provide video via a 65" TV along with speakers to amplify sound.
 - Since we do not know how many people will attend, we encourage as many people as possible to also bring their own personal devices (phone, I-Pad) which can be powered via your own data plan or personal WiFi hotspot.
