## RESOLUTION NO. 92-22

### RECOMMENDING THE USAGE OF ELECTRIC OR HYBRID VEHICLES FOR MUNICIPAL FLEETS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has a goal to achieve 100% clean energy by 2050; and

WHEREAS, a key component of the State of New Jersey's clean energy initiatives is to encourage municipalities to transition their municipal fleets to electric vehicles; and

WHEREAS, supporting the transition to electric or hybrid fleet vehicles contributes to the Township of Morris's commitment to sustainability and is in the best interest of public welfare; and WHEREAS, adoption of this resolution supports the State of New Jersey's goals to reduce air pollutants and greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector as outlined and supported by various programs related to NJ's 2019 Energy Master Plan, Global Warming Response Act (P.L.2007, c.112 (C.26:2C-37 et al.)), and EV Law (P.L. 2019, c. 362); and

WHEREAS, supporting the transition to electric or hybrid fleet vehicles is consistent with the Township of Morris' environmental action plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS (THE "GOVERNING BODY"):

1. The Governing Body encourages the utilization, transition or purchase of electric or hybrid vehicles within the municipal fleet when feasible;
